



TESTING BY NBCE

The CBCN uses the expertise and services of the National Board of Chiropractic Examiners (NBCE) to assist in the preparation and administration of the CBCN examination. As part of its initial examination development activities, the CBCN Examination Committee prepares a database of over 2,000 test questions based on the course syllabus, the course references, the job analysis of Diplomate practice, and the Delphi study.

The job analysis of Diplomate practice, and the Delphi study (a study of nutritional course-work within the profession) are conducted every five years, as needed, to keep the CBCN examination current with established practice and teaching guidelines.
