We serve to advance the use of clinical nutrition in chiropractic practice, protect the public interest, and enhance the health of our patients and the population at large.

The CBCN operates under the auspices of the American Chiropractic Association (ACA) and is a member of the American



Board of Chiropractic Specialties (ABCS) with full autonomy in the areas of testing standards and procedures.

Our testing is performed by the National Board of Chiropractic Examiners (NBCE).



The CBCN is authorized and recognized by the ACA to issue the specialty certification Diplomate (DCBCN) to Doctors of Chiropractic in the field of Clinical Nutrition.
